


#### INTRODUCTION



The MDCAT being a computer-based examination was in accordance with global best practices and a comprehensive data set is now available that was not possible with a pen & paper examination.

Pakistan Medical Commission MDCAT-2021 Data Analysis Report highlights the key findings and insights available through the Computer Based testing system. The data not only provides in depth details regarding the overall result of students from different provinces across the country, the data also highlights the student's performance in every subject part of the MDCAT.

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The MDCAT was successfully held across 22 cities in 25 centres within Pakistan and 6 centres Internationally. Catering to about 200,000 medical and dental aspirants the centres were located across Punjab, Sindh, Baluchistan, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Islamabad Capital Territory, Gilgit Baltistan and Azad Jammu & Kashmir. The centralized computer based testing system has provided an extensive dataset that will help evaluate the quality and standard of higher secondary education across Pakistan.

The following set of graphics showcase the regional breakdown of students attempting and passing the MDCAT. The latter set of graphs present a comprehensive, comparative analysis of students acquiring highest and average scores across different provinces of Pakistan.

The dataset shows that students from Punjab, Islamabad Capital Territory and Azad Jammu & Kashmir have scored the highest overall pass percentage with 42.82% students from Punjab, 38.09% students from Azad Jammu & Kashmir and 46.10% students from Islamabad acquiring 65% and above while attempting the MDCAT.



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#### Subject-Wise Breakdown- Biology

To pursue a career in medicine and dentistry, the prerequisite is to pass the MDCAT and the applicant is to have prior knowledge, both theoretical and practical application of biological sciences at a higher secondary level. The MDCAT 2021 syllabus had a 32% weightage assigned to Biology highlighting the importance of the subject to be eligible for pursuing a medical and dental degree.

The dataset depicts the highest scores achieved in Biology and highlights the standard of higher secondary education and the overall performance of students across Pakistan. The MDCAT questions were framed in a manner whereby the applicant was expected to apply the concepts learned rather than relying on memorised content.

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#### Subject-Wise Breakdown- Chemistry

Chemistry is an integral part of the medical and dental curriculum; the application of chemical sciences is essential in understanding the process of the human body. An understanding of chemical processes and the intricate link between the human body and substances is crucial for the pursuance of a medical or dental degree. With a 26.5% weightage in the MDCAT Syllabus, the students were assessed on their conceptual knowledge and understanding of the subject.

Through the implementation of a single computer based examination, the final cumulative data received will support facilitate the provincial governments to improve the teaching standards at the grassroot levels.

#### **Subject-Wise Breakdown - Physics**

Physics is one of the three sciences essential for a medical and dental degree. In today's day and age, the diagnosis of a patient relies on advanced medical instruments that require an in-depth knowledge of physics. The ability to apply the concepts learnt during higher secondary education plays a crucial role in medical education. Physics too, was assigned a weightage of 26.5% considering it's importance as a core subject to assess the student's eligibility to be admitted in to a medical or dental program.



These tests help identify a student's potential to understand and apply concepts expected from medical or dental education.

This examination would help ensure that every student entering the field of medical study has the necessary aptitude and analytical skills required for medical and dental training programs.



#### Conclusion

A National Medical and Dental Colleges Admissions Test (MDCAT) was introduced in 2020 as part of PMC's strategy to standardize the admission process in the country. Prior to the establishment of the Pakistan Medical Commission, each province conducted their separate medical college entry tests (MDCAT) with different curriculums and examination structures. Thus, the results followed a different method in each province creating a pool of students not given equal opportunities in the entry tests and a varying merit standard. Consequently, deserving students missed out on the chance of medical or dental education.

Pakistan Medical Commission in its first year of formation implemented the mandatory one standard medical and dental college entry test across Pakistan, giving every student an equal opportunity to apply to a medical or dental college. In 2021, for the first time in Pakistan, a computer-based testing system on such a large scale was introduced by the Pakistan Medical Commission. The students were able to register for the examination and choose their preferred date of examination, centre location and timings through their registered profiles. The system was designed in a technologically sound manner where the algorithm ensured that no two applicants received the same set of questions in their respective examinations.

This year, MDCAT was designed to evaluate problem-solving skills, critical thinking and determine competence in natural, behavioural, and social sciences concepts. The data, generated through the computerized testing system gives a thorough insight into the standard of education provided in different provinces across Pakistan. The provincial breakdown of the subject-wise scoring is an identifiable variable of the level and condition of higher secondary education provided in the provinces.
