## SUBJECT: - PRE-BID MEETING (Procurement of Computer Based Examination Services including Operational System

Pre-Bid meeting for the said subject was held on 29th November, 2021 in the Executive Board room of Pakistan Medical Commission (PMC). List of participants is placed at (Annex-A).

Member IT, Member Admin and Member Legal of the National Medical Authority (NMA), of Pakistan Medical Commission answered the queries raised by the participants. As specified in tender, written queries from bidder were supposed to reach PMC team atleast 3 days before the meeting. Agenda of the meeting was shared through tender document "To answer any queries that potential bidders may have".

Following table indicates written queries received before the pre-bid meeting, discussions held during the meeting and NMA's response. Also, it includes queries received from few bidders after the Pre-Bid meeting.

Performance guarantee has been sought to secure the financial terms which is sufficient. Further more a bidder will be paid fee for services on conclusion of each step of the exam hence further securing delivery of service.

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"We understand that the entire scoring criteria (100 marks) split over/ revolved around only one PMC exam which was conducted in September, 2021. Therefore, our understanding is only one company can be qualified through this set criterion which is against the spirit of PPRA rules and CC"

TELCONET commented during the meeting that criteria is favoring one bidder. NMA clarified that criteria are as per the need of PMC for the conduct and management of exam as per the relevant Act and Regulations. NMA took a few examples form evaluation criteria and explained how it is open for all and not having the capacity or particular experience should not be misguided as a fault in the tender. NMA had clarified that
